Video briefs

In addition to the “info slide”, participants are encouraged to send us a **3-5 minute** talk in video format. This may be a recorded presentation, or a simple voiceover describing your info slide, or somewhere in the middle. Our hope is that attendees can get acquainted and educated with the topics ahead of time.

No abstract is required to submit a video brief - we welcome all attendees to have their say!

Like the slide book, all video briefs will be made available one week before the summit.

FAQs

Q: *Can I register now and submit an abstract later?*

A: Yes. Please register normally indicating you “wish to submit an abstract”, and in the subsequent ‘abstract’ textbox just note you intend to submit later. **Submission deadline is on the 25th of March**, so be sure to update that textbox or email us with your abstract by then.

Q: *Are the info slide or video briefs being selected from?*

A: No, all slides and videos will be made public without curation. Only restrictions are max time of 5 minutes for videos, and A4 page format for the info slide.
